Cranes could also be transported to different construction sites on the road as they drive themselves, that eliminates the need for extra transport vehicles. Being able to travel on their own greatly lessens transport costs at the end of the day. The truck crane however is not stable enough to handle all the major loads that a hydraulic crane can handle. Thus, in order to fix this issue, outriggers can be extended from the deck. The outriggers utilize hydraulic pressure to be able to slightly lift the truck off of the ground, making it stable and balanced. The crawler crane is unique in that it has big tracks on the base of the crane. These huge tracks are very like bulldozers and backhoes. The tracks allow the crane to successfully move around a construction site.
